**R – RESPECT - Respect** is the most important part of this classroom. It is essential that you respect yourself, others and your environment. If you respect others, they will respect you in return.

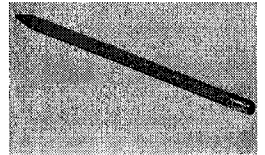
**I – INTEGRITY** – Integrity is defined as being honest and having strong moral principles. Acting with integrity will lead you to becoming a fine, young citizen in the world!
