

Winter Party Celebration

Winter holiday is coming and your parents have promised you that you can have your very own party with 5 of your best friends. The budget for your party is \$250. You want to have the best party ever so you've decided that you are going to include the following things without going a penny over your \$250 budget.

1. Two presents for yourself. One of them must be a clothing item.
2. FOOD!! You want to be able to feed yourself and your friends. Your party must include one main food item like pizza or hot dogs or anything else you and your friends like to chow on, some snack food, and drinks. Make sure you have enough for everyone.
3. A cake for dessert (you can substitute cookies, ice cream)
4. Goody bags for all your friends. Each goody bag will cost \$5.00 for a total of \$30.00 (including one for yourself)
5. You want your party to be lots of fun so you will need some entertainment like going to a movie, going to Lazertag, The Energyplex, tubing at Big White, going to the H2O. Research the cost of these online and remember the tax as well.

How Does It Work?

Cut out pictures from flyers (you can raid your recycling box at home also for flyers) for each of the items above. Glue onto blank paper. Beside the picture show all of your calculations including the final cost of the item after tax. Remember tax in BC is 12%.

The last page of your project will be a 'TOTALS' page. On this page you will list all of the items and total them up. Your goal is to stay on budget and not spend over \$250.

Party Evaluation

- A** - To obtain a mark of 'A' you must:
- Fulfill all of the requirements of a 'B' mark.
 - You were able to spend within \$2.00 of the total amount available and did not exceed \$250.
- B** - To obtain a mark of 'B' you must:
- Fulfill all of the requirements of a C+ mark and the assignment must be completed and handed in on time.
 - Include pictures or advertisements that illustrate your purchases and in some way verify the indicated purchase price.
 - Demonstrate a high degree of organization, care and craft.
 - Color and or graphics have been added to enhance your work.
- C+** - To obtain a mark of 'C+' you must:
- Include a title page.
 - Your name, section, teacher name, and date must be in the lower right corner of the title page and your work must be completed and handed in on time.
 - You must show an itemized list of your purchases and the applicable sales tax on each item.
 - You must show your calculations and the amount left over.
 - Your work must be neat, well organized, and demonstrate care and pride in your effort (use of color would be an asset)
- C** - To obtain a mark of 'C' you must:
- This project is completed to a satisfactory level and shows that you understand the purpose, however parts are missing or misinterpreted.
 - This assignment has errors in:
 - Organization
 - The written text or calculations
 - Legibility and neatness
 - Completion of required elements
 - Some parts of the assignment appear to be completed without a high degree of thoughtfulness and/or care.
- C-** This project is minimally satisfactory. Generally, it is complete but sections of the assignment may be poorly done, incomplete and/or full of errors. The required elements and/or the graphic work appears to be hastily completed without a great degree of thought given nor has there been attention to detail, craft, or neatness.
- I** **Incomplete**
- This assignment is incomplete and/or shows little understanding of the project's purpose.
